<p><u>Body Systems:</u> The human body is unique in its heredity, body systems and development and can be affected by the environment.</p>	<p>a. There are external structures that provide for the survival needs of human organisms. (Skin protects the body from harmful substances and other organisms and from drying out; The skeletal system provides shape and protection for the body's organs; The brain gets/gives signals from/to all parts of the body "telling" the body what to do; From food, people obtain nutrients and other materials for body repair and growth. The undigestible parts of food are eliminated. Key structures are mouth, esophagus, stomach, intestine and anus; By breathing, people take in the oxygen that they need to live.
