<p><b>How do you gain information about your world?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Information is gathered by each sense (e.g., touch:heat, rough, hardness).</li><li>- Information can be gathered from multiple senses simultaneously.</li><li>- Body parts are used by each sense: skin - touch; eyes - sight; ears - hearing; mouth - taste; nose - smell.</li></ul>	<p>What sense(s) do you use to identify ____ ?</p> <p>Mystery box, to identify items by touch.</p> <p>Visual check of mystery box: include - color, shape, size.</p> <p>Taste test w/ blindfold</p> <p>Identify taped sounds.</p> <p>Mystery containers to identify by smell.</p> <p>I wonder what would happen if we couldn't: see, hear, taste, smell or feel?</p>
